Frequently Asked Questions

Who may take these classes?

Any lay person or authorized minister in the Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island Conferences, and beyond who wishes to further his/her education and understanding of faith formation. *Please note that these classes do not meet requirements for ordination.*

Where are the class sessions held?

There are two locations for you to choose from for each class offered:

Do I have to attend the class at both locations?

No; just choose the location and/or date that is most convenient for you for each class offered.

How long is each class?

Each class begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 12:30 p.m.

What is the cost?

Individual session: \$45 each One year of 3 classes: \$125

We encourage the local church to cover the cost of their participant as a show of support for this training.

Can I attend these courses via web conferencing?

Yes!

But only the sessions held at the Northampton site/date. Just select that option when you register. However we strongly recommend that you attend the classes in person, if you are able, to gain the most from face to face contact with the instructors and students.

Do I have to complete the CE Certification Program or can I just take one or a few classes?

All classes are open to both those who are pursuing CE Certification and all others who are interested in only a specific class or classes. CE Certification is an option for those who desire to complete the two years of classes and other requirements.

How do I register?

When is the registration deadline?

There is no deadline, however an early registration will guarantee your receipt of any advanced reading materials, class logistics, and cancellations if needed.

Tell me more about CE Certification.

The Massachusetts Conference UCC Christian Educator Certification Program is for church leaders and local church educators who wish to develop skills for creating and/or leading a progressive, comprehensive, and exceptional faith formation ministry in their local churches. Church educators are persons who may serve in the role of church school superintendent, director/coordinator of Christian education, pastor, other authorized minister, and/or church school teacher, for instance. The Certification Certificate, presented at the completion of the program (see http://www.macucc.org/certification for details) will indicate that the educator has achieved a certain level of proficiency as a church educator that is recognized by the Massachusetts Conference UCC.

Tell me more about Faith Formation Classes for All.

The classes in the Christian Educator Certification Program listed in this brochure are offered to anyone from a local congregation who is interested in furthering his/her knowledge and understanding of the Christian faith and the work of the Church. If the student is not interested in Christian Educator Certification, he/she need only to choose one of the classes or as many as desired. No certificate is granted; however, the student may request official documentation of his/her participation in a class or classes.
