

THE 3 CHOICES FOR THE INSTITUTIONAL CHURCH

CHURCH 2.0

- Primary focus is on satisfying membership and maintaining the organization/institution/building,etc
- Pastor is the performer
- Pastor spends 100% of time serving the congregation
- More memories than imagination.
- Budget cuts impact mission and program first
- Vision, if there is one, and strategic planning focused on getting more people in the pews and pledges in the plate.
- Institutional Maintenance.

CHURCH 2.6

- Primary focus is on fulfilling God's Vision
- Faith Formation for all ages impacts 75% of the congregation. Intentional Spiritual Practice.
- Pastor spends 50% of time serving the congregation and 50% in the community
- Budget realigned to accomplish vision.
- Congregation is the performer
- Success measured by impact not numbers
- Forming community partnerships and networks to accomplish vision.

CHURCH 3.0

- Primary focus is on encountering God.
- Faith Formation for all ages impacts 100% of the congregation.
- Pastor spends 25% of time serving the congregation and 75% in the community
- Budget growing to meet ministry/movement needs
- Congregation is fluid
- Success measured by impact not numbers
- Birthed out of the needs of community members.
- Typically not building centered
